Since the end of the summer water run, and due to continued inflow into the lake, Lower Tule has continued to earn water in storage in Lake Success. We are required by the Army Corps of Engineers to be at minimum pool, 9,095 AF in storage by November 10. Therefore, Lower Tule will be starting a small release from the lake tomorrow. There will not be enough water to make irrigation deliveries, so the water will remain in the river and be percolated in the district. We may also move it around to other areas of the District to bolster recharge in certain areas. If there are any questions please let me know.
