TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PERMIT:

1. Plans and specifications for proposed work must be submitted to and approved by District. The plans must contain section view of the proposed crossing. It shall also include the nearest crossroad and the location of the crossing. A GPS coordinate shall be included.
2. Any electrical line and high-pressure line must be incased in a steel casing.
3. The top of the pipe shall be 3ft-5ft below the existing grade of the canal.
4. The proposed crossing shall be perpendicular to the canal.
5. Utility marker, indicating type of utility, shall be installed in both side of the canal and shall be outside the District Right of Way. (Typically, outside toe of the canal)
6. Applicant shall comply with all applicable local, state, and federal rules and regulations affecting the proposed project.
7. Applicant shall implement safety measures and precautions to protect the public at all times.
8. Applicant shall contact Underground Service Alert (U.S.A. – 1-800-422-4133) two working days prior to beginning any construction which involves excavation.
9. Applicant shall restore District property to its pre-license condition upon completion of the project.
10. Applicant shall pay the District's application fee, if applicable, to cover administrative costs, including inspections deemed necessary by District.
11. Applicant shall keep District's property free and clear of all liens and encumbrances related to its project.
12. Applicant shall provide a certificate of insurance adequate to cover the proposed project which names District and its officers, employees, and agents as additional insured's.
13. District makes no warranty of title. Once issued, the permit is subject to and shall not interfere with the District's use of its facilities. District shall have the superior right to determine and enforce the proper use, repair and maintenance of the encroached property as if the permit did not exist.
14. Once issued, the permit shall continue until revoked. It is deemed revocable at any time by District, in whole or in part, without any liability to District. This revocation includes authority to remove all obstructions and improvements installed by applicant, if applicant does not do so after thirty (30) calendar days' notice from District. The costs of such removal and restoration shall constitute a lien against Applicant's property, without further notice, upon recording of a notice by District of the expenses incurred.
15. In the event of revocation by District, applicant shall, upon demand, promptly execute a quitclaim deed of its rights hereunder.
16. Once issued, the permit shall bind and insure to the successors and assigns of District and Applicant.
