One of TBWQC's many goals is to keep you informed of news and developments that may have an impact on your irrigated farming operations.

One common Frequently Asked Question we receive is whether the TBWQC is the same as the [Sustainable Groundwater Management Act \(SGMA\)](#). The answer is no, but we do coordinate efforts where it makes sense for efficiencies. The Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) which your property resides within is the Lower Tule Groundwater Sustainability Agency (LTGSA). We encourage you to join LTGSA's [Interested Parties List](#), which will allow you to receive notices regarding Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) preparation, meeting announcements, events, developments, and ways to get involved.

Along with 5 other GSAs operating in the Tule Subbasin, Lower Tule GSA has been tasked with bringing this region's groundwater resources into a sustainable balance through the implementation of a GSP, due January 31, 2020 and will outline how the Agency will achieve the mandated goals of SGMA by 2040 (at the latest).
